SPEAKER POWERPOINT PROGRAMS



The Scientific Library staff currently offers a Bibliographies service, whereby we create selective web bibliographies for specific speakers and mount them on our web site. Within each bibliography we include links to full-text journal articles, when available. We provide this service to help NCI-Frederick personnel prepare for upcoming lectures, or to read follow-up articles after attending lectures.

We have now expanded that service to include speaker PowerPoint slide programs. We are asking designated speakers to provide us with their PowerPoint slide programs, which we then adapt for the web. We display the links to available PowerPoint programs beside the bibliographies of participating speakers. The PowerPoint programs, which are only posted after the actual lectures have been presented, offer excellent follow-up research opportunities to anyone who attended the lectures, as well as to anyone who could not attend. We plan to archive these PowerPoint slide programs so they will be available for future viewing.

We are aware that some speakers may be reluctant to share their PowerPoint programs with the general public, so we limit access to NCI-Frederick personnel only. In addition, the service is completely voluntary, so we honor the requests of those speakers who do not wish to have their slides appear on our web site.

RETRACTIONS OF PUBLICATIONS

The staff of the Scientific Library provides this service to alert our readers to any journal articles that are being retracted by the authors. Often, research that is undertaken to support the ideas in journal articles is questioned by other scientists. If the original authors then publish a formal retraction of all or parts of the original article, MEDLINE indexes that new article as “RETRACTION OF PUBLICATION” in the “publications type” field.

When a new retraction appears in MEDLINE, and subsequently in our newsletter, staff members type alerts that are permanently attached to the original articles. In this way, if a scientist is reading the original article, he/she will immediately be aware of the published retraction, and will be able to easily locate it in the journal collection.
