

Appendix A: Confined Space Entry Program Organizational Chart

There is a line of authority and primary communication between EHS (Environment, Health and Safety), the Confined Space Coordinator, and the Fire Department.

There is a line of authority and primary communication from the Confined Space Coordinator to the Department Supervisor, and then the Entry Supervisor.

The Entry Supervisor has a line of authority and primary communication between the Entrant and Attendant, who also have a line of authority and primary communication between each other.

Additionally, the Fire Department has a line of communication for emergency response planning and action with the Entry Supervisor, the Entrant, and the Attendant.

EHS also has an additional line of communication for entry notification and closure with the Entry Supervisor.

The Attendant is not required for non-PRCS entry by authorized personnel only.
